



Unplugged Colouring Contest Complete Rules and Regulations

The *Unplugged* Contest (the “Contest”) is presented by the Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership as part of the *Unplug and Play Week* Campaign held during the month of January, 2018.

1. Entry Deadline:

11:59 PM PST January 31, 2018.

2. Eligibility Criteria

2.1. To participate in the Contest, Entrants must drop off their Unplug and Play colouring sheet (the “Entry”) to participating Unplug and Play agencies before the end of the Contest deadline. No purchase or entry fee is required.

2.2. Entrants must be:

- Over the ages of majority in British Columbia as of January 1, 2018 (or if under the age of majority, have obtained expressed parental permission to submit the entry);
- Residents of the Central Okanagan Regional District, in the Province of British Columbia;
- Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada or protected persons designated by the Immigration and Refugee Board or Citizenship and Immigration Canada;

2.3. Entrants under the age of majority in their province or territory of permanent residence must include the signed consent of the Entrant’s parent or legal guardian.

2.4. Contest judges, Unplug and Play committee members and their immediate families, are not eligible to participate in the Contest.

2.5. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership reserves the right to request verification of these eligibility criteria from the Entrant at any time.

2.6. Any incomplete or fraudulent entries will be disqualified. Any Entrant or other individual who enters or attempts to enter the Contest in a manner contrary to the Rules and Regulations or which is otherwise disruptive to the proper operation of the Contest or by its nature is unjust to other Entrants or potential Entrants or for any other reason at the sole discretion of the Unplug and Play committee will be rejected and that Entrant or purported Entrant will be disqualified from the Contest without notice.

3. Submission Criteria

3.1. All Entries must be:

- Submitted with the expressed use of Unplug and Play themed activities;
- Submitted by the Entrant, or Entrants for the purpose of entering the Contest and not have been previously published in any format whatsoever;
- Submitted to participating Unplug and Play agencies/organizations

3.2. Entries must demonstrate how the Entrant, or Entrants, is/are involved in or celebrating Unplug and Play and shares:

- Unplug and Play Week Community Activities;
- What they wish to do with their families to continue to commit to technology balance beyond Unplug and Play Week; and/or
- How balancing technology with other healthy family activities has impacted their lives

3.3. Entries must only contain original works (including music, texts, artworks, graphics, photographs, or videos) created by the Entrant, works licensed to the Entrant or copyright-free works.

3.4. Entries must not be defamatory, trade libelous, pornographic or obscene as determined by the Unplug and Play committee in its sole discretion and must not contain, depict, include, discuss or involve, any combination of the following without limitation:

- Promotion, endorsement or discussion of any unlawful, harmful, threatening, or abusive activity or conduct;
- Vulgar or offensive language and/or images;
- Nudity, graphic or explicit sexuality;
- Hateful, derogatory or otherwise offensive or objectionable characterizations or generalizations of any ethnic, racial, sexual or religious groups;
- Reference to or endorsement by any political parties;
- Personal information of individuals, including names and addresses (physical or email);
- Commercial messages, endorsements, comparisons or solicitations for products or services (other than Success by 6 products or services) or for any organization or individual providing such products or services;
- Any other content that is or could be considered inappropriate, unsuitable or offensive, as determined by Success by 6 in its sole discretion.

3.7. Multiple entries may be submitted as long as they conform to these Rules and Regulations.

3.8. Entrants are solely responsible for ensuring that their Entry is submitted in and received in compliance with these Rules and Regulations.

3.9. All entries submitted to the Unplug and Play Committee become the property of the Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership and will not be returned to the Entrant (Entrants should keep a copy).

4. Judging

4.1. On February 1, 2017, three entries will be selected in a random draw held in Kelowna, British Columbia. The first entry drawn will be the winner and will be contacted within 5 business days at time of submission.

4.2. Once notified, the winner must contact Success by 6 by email at amanda@unitedwaycso.com or via the method contacted within five (5) days of receiving the notice by e-mail to acknowledge that they accept the prize and they provide proof of age and residence in the Central Okanagan, parental or guardian consent and any other permissions or information requested by the Unplug and Play Committee at its sole discretion. If the individual does not provide such information or the information is not acceptable or if the individual does not contact Success by 6 within this timeframe, or if there is any reason a winner cannot accept the prize as awarded, his/her entry will be declared null and void, and an alternate winner will be chosen from the remaining two finalists. The Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership will not be held responsible for unsuccessful attempts to notify an individual due to incorrect or incomplete contact information provided by the individual.

4.3. The winners' names may be announced and posted on the Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership and United Way CSO website or published by any other means during the month of February, 2017. All decisions by Contest judges with respect to the Contest are final without right of appeal.

5. Prizes

5.1. The Prize will be awarded as follows:

- Grand Prize: One (1) Artist Prize Pack

5.2. The chance of winning will depend on the number of qualified entries that adhere to the Rules and Regulations. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership reserves the right not to award prizes for any reason.

5.3. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and are non-refundable, non-transferable and non-redeemable for any cash value. The Unplug and Play Committee reserves the right to make prize substitutions.

5.4. The winner will be responsible for prize pick up.

6. Use of Entry by Success by 6

6.1. By submitting a Contest Entry (or Entries), Entrants consent to:

- The use of their image in accordance with these Rules and Regulations;
- License all intellectual property rights in and to the Entry to Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership; and
- Waive all their moral rights in and to the Entry in favour of Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership.

6.2. At any time Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership may, including but without limitation, upload, reformat, edit, translate, copy, reproduce, display, distribute, transmit by telecommunication, and make the Entries accessible and available on Unplug and Play or United Way CSO website and social media channels (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Instagram) or by any other means without notice or compensation to the Entrants/finalists/winners. Entries may also be used for future promotional purposes in connection with the Contest or Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership/Unplug and Play activities, without limitation and without further notice or compensation. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership is under no obligation to use the Entries as provided herein.

7. Use of Personal Information

7.1. By entering the Contest and submitting a Contest Entry, Entrants expressly consent to the collection, use, storage and disclosure of their personal information by Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership for the purposes of administering the Contest as well as for the other purposes expressly contemplated in these Rules and Regulations in accordance with the federal Privacy Act. Entrants expressly consent that Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership may use the Entrants' personal information to communicate with them and to announce and/or post the names of the finalists and winners on the Unplug and Play and United Way website and social media channels, and/or by any other means in connection with the Entries. **Under no circumstances are submitted personal information given, sold, or revealed to third party individuals or organizations.**

8. Disclaimers and Exclusion of Liability

8.1. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership, its employees, agents, contractors, assigns or successors assume no responsibility for Contest entries that are lost, stolen, tampered with, late, damaged, misdirected, received through impermissible channels, illegible or unintelligible for any reason or for any other circumstance that may limit an individual's ability to participate in the Contest or otherwise affect the administration, security, impartiality or normal course of the Contest.

8.2. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership, its employees, contractors, assigns and successors will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage of any kind caused by or resulting from an Entrant's participation or attempted participation in the Contest, compliance or non-compliance with these Contest Rules and Regulations or an Entrant's acceptance, use or misuse of any prize awarded to the Entrant.

8.3. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership will not be liable to any Entrant for any indirect, special, consequential or punitive damages in connection with the Contest or these Rules and Regulations.

9. General

9.1. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership reserves the right to exclude from the Unplug and Play and United Way website and social media channels any Contest Entry that does not comply with these Rules and Regulations or for any reason that Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership determines in its sole discretion without notice at any time.

9.2. Central Okanagan Early Years Partnership reserves the right to modify, suspend or cancel the Contest in whole or in part at any time without notice for any reason at its sole discretion.

9.3. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial, and territorial laws. This Contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law.
